

Youth Theatre 2022 Info

Youth Theatre 2022 will once again be made up of two casts. The performance cast which will have the opportunity to perform in our mainstage production of *Freaky Friday* and the development cast which will have the opportunity to be involved in a weeklong workshop during the April School holidays.

There will be two sign-up nights this year these will be on Wednesday the 23rd of February from 6:30-8pm and then Wednesday the 2nd of March from 6:30-8pm. We will only be taking applicants who attend one of these two nights in person with their form fully filled out and applicable monies paid.

We will be taking up to 60 people in the performance cast up to the discretion of the 2022 Youth Theatre team.

Please note: Youth Theatre Membership is open to persons **aged between 10 and 18 years**. Youth Theatre Membership entitles the student to participate in workshops held by the Bundaberg Players Incorporated exclusively. This membership does not cover any other membership rights.

Performance Cast Info

This year, the performance cast membership will cost \$75 and this money will also include a t-shirt. The first official night will be Wednesday the 9th of March from 6:30pm to 8:30pm, and then for term one it will be every Wednesday night. It will then be Monday and Wednesday nights with the addition of Sunday afternoons later within the rehearsal campaign for term 2. If you are going to be away for more than **THREE** of the rehearsal dates, please contact us to discuss further options.

Please note there will be no rehearsals in the April school holidays but there will be rehearsals in the June/July school holidays as the performance for *Freaky Friday* is in the middle weekend. A more in-depth schedule will be handed out once rehearsals commence.

Please note the following:

- Please sign in and out every night
- Please use the provided hand sanitizer on the way in and out
- Please wear enclosed footwear EVERY rehearsal. You will not be allowed on the stage/be able to participate otherwise.
- Please always wear appropriate clothing... Youth Theatre is mixed ages and sexes
- Please bring a water bottle with you name on it
- A folder and a few pencils are always great to have to easily organize anything we give out and to be able to write things down and take notes if needed.
- Please be prompt at dropping off and picking up your child/children.

- Please be quiet when entering and exiting the building, we are in a residential neighbourhood.

Development Cast Info

The development cast workshop will run from the 5th to the 8th of April, each day will be 9-5 except for the final day which will be 9-1 with a small performance beginning at 6pm that evening. More information about this will go out once we know who each cast is.

The cost for the development cast is \$50 which covers a basic Youth Theatre membership.

Vaccination Information
