I Want to be in a Jane Austen Novel is the work of Brisbane writer Joanna Butler. She wrote and directed the play in 2006 for Brisbane's Harvest Rain Theatre Company, where it was met with great acclaim. The ABC Bell Awards named her Best Playwright and the Delarte Awards sent the Favourite Playwright and Favourite Play honours her way.
